## Fundraising ideas for your school day

### DRESS LOUD

We'll be dressing loud on **Friday 5th October** for Global's Make Some Noise Day and we'd love for you to join us.

Your pupils could each donate £2 to wear their brightest and wackiest clothes for the day. The bolder they look, the better!

### NO NOISE

This one's great for a classroom full of chatterboxes. Your class, year group or whole school could have a go at staying silent for 15 minutes or longer. Sounds great, right?

Set your pupils an achievable target like £5 each that they can raise from family and friends. Mark the end of the sponsored silence with the loudest shout of MAKE SOME NOISE.

### SHOUT OUT LOUD

Get your ear plugs at the ready. Put a spin on a sponsored silence by asking pupils to play instruments or exercise their "outside voices" for a minute of noise in the playground.

You could even turn it into a noise-a-thon! No doubt your students will love the opportunity to be as loud as they can be. Encourage your pupils to raise as much as they can from family and friends to take on the sponsored challenge.

### BAKE SOME NOISE

Everyone loves cake, don't they? A bake sale is a fun and easy way to raise money at school. We've got bunting, cake labels, collection boxes and much more to help make your cake sale a sweet success.

## Fundraising ideas for your lunch break

### BAKE OFF

Take a bake sale one step further and turn it into a challenge at school. Who will come out on top? Like a cherry on top.

Students, or even staff could go head-to-head to be crowned a Make Some Noise star baker.

### LET'S HEAR YOU

It's time to see the students in front of the crowds. Run a competition during lunchtime and challenge teams of students to make loud music with anything but instruments. How creative can they be?

Get each pupil to make a small donation to take part or to enjoy the entertainment. The top performing class could reach out to local businesses to ask for some matched funding.

### PUMP UP THE FUN

Kids really do have the wildest imaginations. Get your students to design their loud outfits and model them on a catwalk at school. Think sequins, tutus, wigs – anything goes.

Charge students and teachers to be in the audience and offer prizes for the top three creative costumes. Get in touch with local businesses to source the prizes.

### COLOUR CRAZE

Turn your PE kit from white to bright for a colour fun run during your lunch hour. Lace up your trainers and get the whole school out on the field for a 1k colour clash and dash.

Set a rate to take part. You could raise even more money by turning this into a family fun run at the weekend.

# LOUDEST

## Fundraising ideas for after school

### CREATE A RACKET

Be inspired by Global's radio stations and find the radio personalities in your school for a special live radio show. You might even be invited as a special guest.

Charge friends and parents entry for a seat in the audience and throw in a quick quiz in between songs.

### TWIST AND SHOUT

Music sounds better with you! A big noisy event is the perfect way to bring everyone together for a blast of fundraising action.

Host a talent show or a school disco, and get the party started with PINK, twist and shout to the Beatles, and sing-along to Girls A-Loud's Sound of the Underground.

Charge an entry fee and give out prizes for the best performances or loudest outfits.

### SING OUT LOUD

Bring the school together in your dining hall or assembly hall to hit the high notes in a karaoke contest.

Ask pupils to donate to hear their 'favourite' teacher sing...or NOT sing, as the case may be and let a panel of students from different classes judge the winners.

### TURN UP THE VOLUME

For one night only, set up the big screen for a sing-along classic like The Sound of Music or Disney's Frozen.

Get kids and parents to pay for the pleasure of singing and sell snacks to get a five-star rating.
